## BAKERY FIRM HERE HAS NEW OWNERS

Purchase of Nelson's bakery, 1614 Hewitt avenue, was announced Tuesday by the new purchasers, Mr. and Mrs. Karl K. Fomaneschi, 1018 Wetmore avenue, who took over operation of the firm Monday. The new operators said they will retain the present firm name and will "strive to maintain the courteous and efficient service which has won high respect for Mr. Nelson in past years." The present personnel will remain with the new owners, Mr. Romaneschi said.

Mr. Romaneschi was associated with the Consumers' Yeast company in Everett for nine years and prior to that he was connected with the baking business in the Grays Harbor area.

Mr. Nelson stated his future business plans are not definite, but he will remain in Everett. Right now, he said, the Nelsons' first interest is to pay a visit in the near future to their son, Aviation Cadet I. W. Nelson, who is preparing for his army "wings" in a course at Maxwell field, Alabama.

Mr. Nelson is well known here, having been engaged for many years in the baking business, moving his business to the present address from the old Grand Central market four years ago.
